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Statewide

CALIFORNIA

Corrections to the <u>Hospital Outpatient Departments/Ambulatory Surgical Centers portion</u> of the fee schedule have been made by the **Division of Workers' Compensation** (DWC). These changes apply to services rendered March 15 and after.

The DWC also announced its new <u>FROI/SROI Implementation Guide</u>, <u>Version 3.1</u> takes effect March 27and can be accessed on the <u>Workers' Compensation Information System (WCIS)</u> site.

MICHIGAN

The state's **Workers' Compensation Agency** has announced its <u>Medical Fee Schedule update is live</u> and went into effect March 15.

NORTH DAKOTA

The state has <u>posted a list of services that are not reimbursable</u> by **Workforce Safety and Insurance** (WSI). These services were deemed unnecessary to treat or diagnose a compensable work injury and are generally considered preventive.



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
